The building known as Club Octane has been in its current incarnation since 2000 and previously was called McGarrett's and prior to that The Club. The building has been an entertainment venue since its construction in 1979. Through the years the club has earned numerous awards including best dance club, best rock club, and many other accolades. It wasn't until the year 2000 after a million dollar remodel that Club Octane started to gain national attention in magazines and web sites as one of the must visit locations in Central California. The inside of Club Octane is a feast for the senses with each room offering a little something different. A highlight of these rooms is listed below.

#### The Lava Lounge:

The locals spot to mix, the only room located on the 1st floor of Octane this club room holds 99 people and features seating as well as a two station bar. A small stage for performances or speakers including a big screen for presentations as well as a dance floor and sound system. The decor is a wild mix leaning toward rock and alternative music. Think comfortable local experience.

#### The VIP Geisha room:

The smallest and most intimate of Octane's rooms. This room holds 18 people and can come with your own dedicated server on request. The room features lounge type seating. Views of Monterey's main street are visible in three directions from the solarium that covers the whole room. You will also have views of the Back Room through a one way window. The decor is done in an Asian style. Think classic Asian sitting room redone for the millennium.

#### The Back Room:

The 2nd largest of Octane's club rooms the Back Room holds 153 people boasts a 4 station round bar, a dance floor and sound system. Six TV's are located over the bar and a big screen projector is also available. The video system has the ability to show VHS, DVD, as well as hookup to power point presentation through S-video. For additional room the VIP Geisha Room may be rented in addition to this. The decor in this room is sparse with Mirrors lining either end of the room and views being available from windows that line the two remaining walls. This room is one of the most versatile rooms we have and is often rented for small to medium size events.

### The Starlight Solarium and the Tiki Bar:

Another very versatile room that is shaped like an "L" and can hold up to 130 people. The whole room is enclosed with a solarium giving you views of downtown Monterey on one side and views of the convention center and the coast on the other. This is one of the largest rooms in Monterey enclosed with a solarium. Either end of the "L" has a separate bar. The long end is the Starlight Solarium featuring couches and tables. One of the more relaxing rooms in the club the decor leans heavily on the views and relaxing atmosphere. Think big city lounge. The short leg of the "L" is called the Tiki Bar and boasts a Hawaiian type theme with a dance space and sound system as well as booth style seating along with tables and chairs. This is one of only two rooms that opens onto an outdoor deck. The deck boasts views of the bay and is a welcome refresher on warm evenings. Think Hawaiian vacation.

### The Main Room:

Octane's largest room holding up to 300. Featuring four bar stations, 16 TV's (Eight of which are in the floor), state of the art lighting and sound, a dance cage (this can be removed for presentations), multilevel dance floor, large stage for acts or presentations, seating, and access to the outdoor patio. The Main Room is done in deep colors and coppers. Think big city dance club.
